## Dining Hall Rental Agreement

Welcome to White Oak Campground's Dining Hall. Thank you for hosting your event using our facility. As a private, Christian and Methodist Campground, we require both polite, civilized, and kind behavior from all our tenants and guests.

### What's available with your rental:

- One handicapped bathroom - is located on the front porch of the Dining Hall.
- 2 electric stoves/ovens with above ventilation hood – we ask that if you use our stove/oven that you please stay inside the building while in use. Our stoves do have a glass top.
- 1 – refrigerator/freezer combo
- 1 – small deep freezer
- 3 – double stainless-steel sinks
- 10 – 8 ft long tables
- 87 – folding chairs
- 1 – long serving bar. This has an open storage area on the backside. Please note that there aren't any outlets available for items placed on the serving bar.
- 3 – industrial stainless-steel preparation tables. There is an outlet available in the ceiling above the tables.
- 2 – industrial size trash cans with push lids
- 1 – small microwave
- Playground - located at the front of the dining hall
- Note: Utensils and table coverings are not provided with rentals

## Rules for the use of our facility

- No more than 100 guests may occupy the Dining Hall.
- The renter (on booking) must be 21 years of age and older and agrees to be present at ALL TIMES during the allotted rental time.
- All doors must remain unlocked for the entire rental.
- The only decorations permitted in the dining hall are those which may be placed on the floor or on the tables. We DO NOT permit the use of any tape, command strips, puddy, nails, tacks, or staples inside or on the porch area.
- Glitter, confetti, silly string, and dancing powders are strictly prohibited.
- Bubbles and birdseed may be used outside and away from the porch area.
- Fireworks, firearms, sparklers and candles are prohibited.
- No use of charcoal grills.
- No campfires allowed at any time.
- Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are not allowed at any time.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in or around buildings located throughout the Campground.
- Please no heavy items causing marring or scratching are permitted to be dragged across the floor.
- Tables and chairs are not to be moved outside for any reason.
- No PETS allowed. The only exception to this rule will be service animals.
- No playing loud or obscene music.
- Any items left behind and not retrieved will be discarded within 5 days of rental.
- In the event of an emergency or fire please call 911 immediately.

## Departure Rules

- Please leave our dining hall the way you found it upon arrival!
- Remove all trash from our facility. This includes the dining hall, bathroom, and playground area if used. Garbage bags are to be placed in the herby curby's next to the Dining Hall side door.
- Please wipe down all used surfaces to include tables, countertops, sinks, refrigerator, freezer and stoves if used.
- Please leave tables and chairs set up the way you found them on arrival. It is extremely time-consuming when our cleaners come in if they have to rearrange it for the next event.
- Please sweep the entire dining hall.
- Please clean out and do not leave anything in the refrigerator or freezer.
- Lock all doors upon departure.
